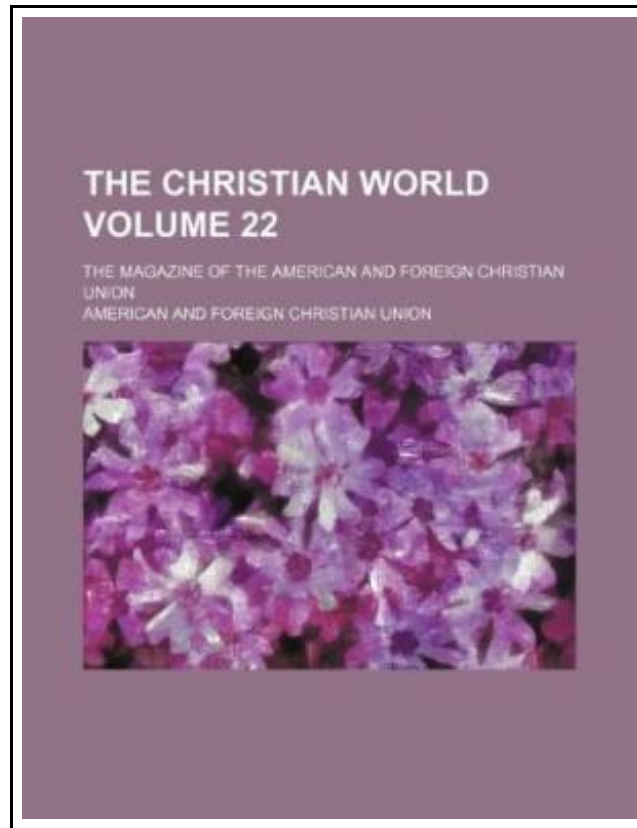

Not illustrated. 1871 Excerpt: . . . distributed the Catholic and Protestant version of the Bible; and have made besides about twenty visits to the Cincinnati Hospital, ten to the Childrens Home, one to the County Jail, and the Orphan Asylum, three to the House of Refuge, and, occasionally to the Home of the Friendless. My Industrial School numbers seventy girls. I have distributed 17, 250 tracts, 500 cards, and 500 religious books. Several have professed conversion, two have united with the evangelical churches, and whole families turned from beggary and idleness, to industry, respectability and hope. Two thirds of my scholars, in regular attendance, have hope that they love Jesus. --Homes for four children, and one adult, and employment for eleven persons have been obtained. The Gospel of love could be carried to every dark adode, and every heart be made to feel its power, if Christians would unite to do the work. It does not require learned ministers of the Gospel, but there are plenty of pious women who could accomplish this task, if directed and sustained. A tithe of the needless expenditures in dress, and the luxuries of the table, would support fifty ladies in this work, instead of two. The demand seems urgent, and the means so simple, why can it not be done Many localities require special effort for the poor children; many of these ragged boys and girls are employed in begging for their vicious parents: the voice of love may win their confidence, and the hand...
